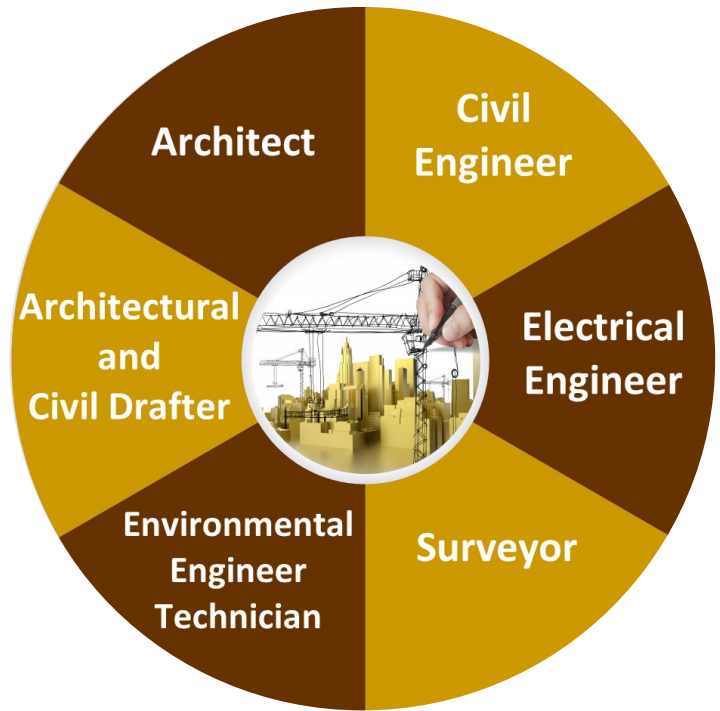

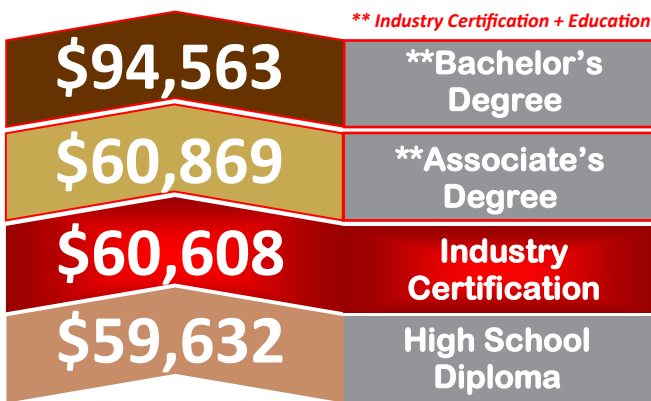
The Engineering and Architecture sector is designed to provide

Not all occupations require a college degree.

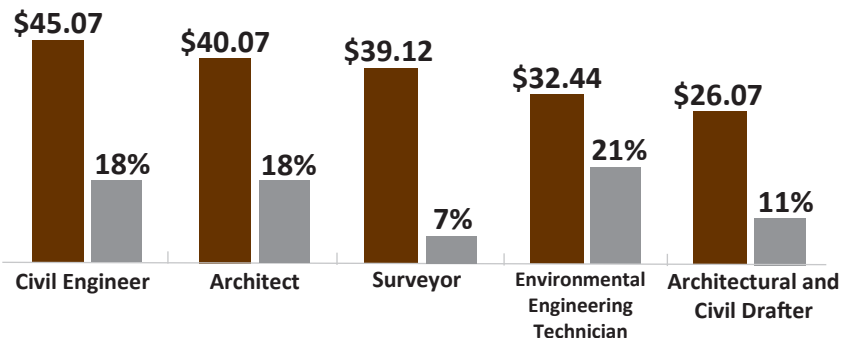
