- The type of work must be seasonal or temporary.

Our Vision

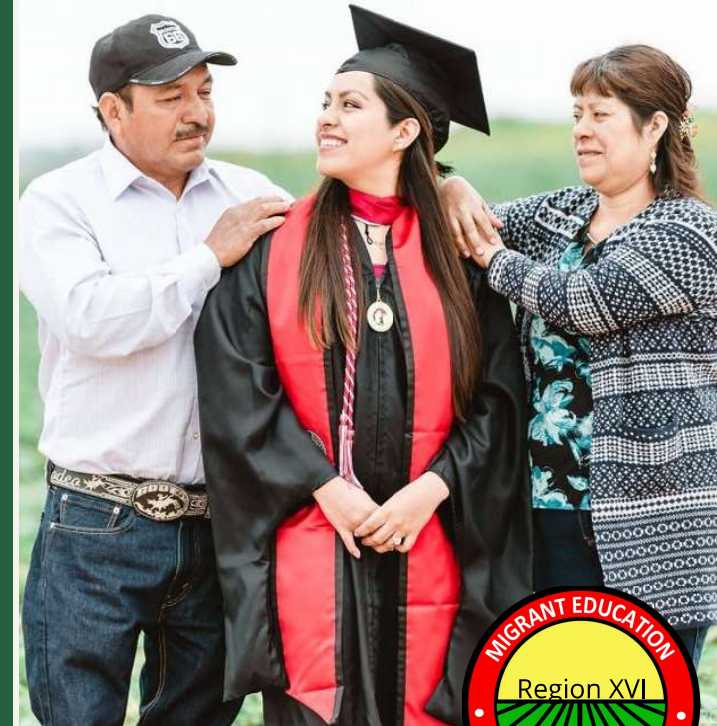

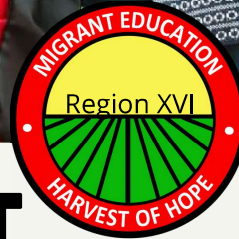
