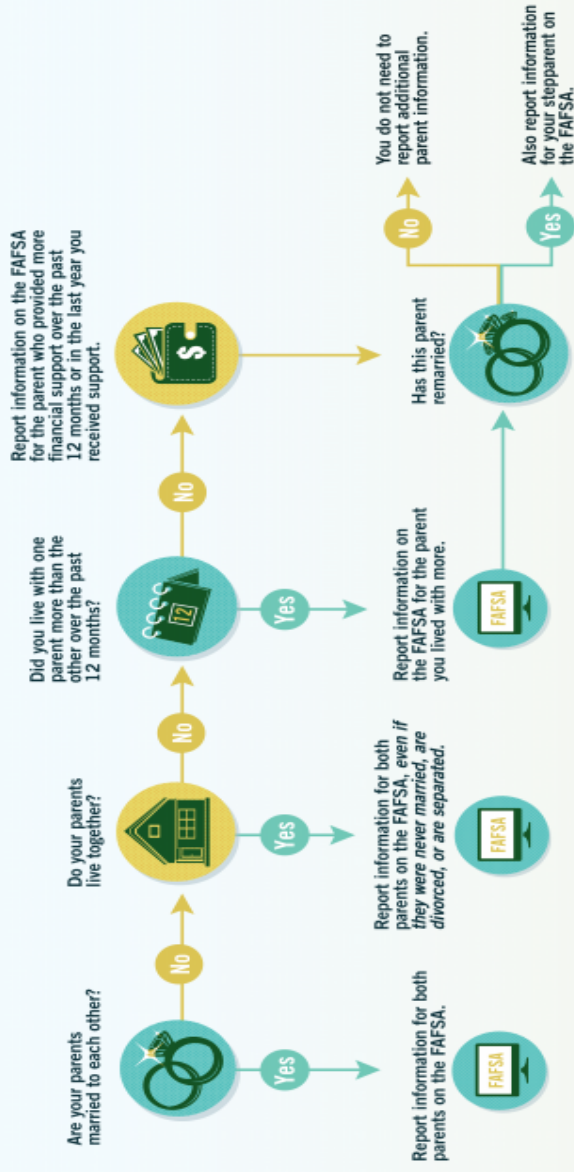
- Records of untaxed income such as: unemployment benefits, workers comp, disability, or child support paid or received  
*Registros de ingresos libres de impuestos (desempleo, compensación de trabajo, manutención de los hijos)*
- Investments (i.e., stocks, bonds, mutual funds, 529 plans) excluding home and retirement / INVERSIONES

Did anyone in the household receive: Medicaid, supplemental security income (SSI), supplemental Nutrition Assistance (SNAP), Free/reduced lunch, Temporary assistance for needy families (CALWORKS), Special supplemental nutrition program (WIC)

# WHO'S MY PARENT WHEN I FILL OUT MY FAFSA?

Dependent students are required to report parent information on the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)*.<sup>1</sup> For reporting purposes, "PARENT" means your legal (biological or adoptive) parent or stepparent, or a person that the state has determined to be your legal parent.

Use this guide to figure out which parent's information to include (depending on your family situation).



The following people are not your parents unless they have legally adopted you:

- Widowed Stepparent
- Grandparents
- Foster Parents
- Legal Guardians
- Older Brothers or Sisters
- Aunts or Uncles
