TRANSPORTATION ROUTES AND SERVICES

Routes and Bus Stops

The Superintendent or designee shall design transportation routes and stops to promote the safety of students and maximum efficiency in the use of buses.

Salinas Union High School District offers school transportation to students who are eligible. Students must live within District boundaries to be eligible for transportation and live two miles or more from their school of residence.

Walking distances to a school of residence:

- 1. Grades 7-8: two miles
- 2. Grades 9-12: two miles

The Superintendent or designee may authorize transportation within the walking distance when safety problems or hazards exist.

Students who attend a school outside their attendance area may be eligible for transportation services in accordance with Governing Board policy.

Transportation Services

With the Board's authorization, transportation services may be provided or arranged by the District for:

- 1. Students traveling to and from school during the regular school day (Education Code
- 2. Field trips and excursions (Education Code 35330)

- 3. School activities, expositions or fairs, or other activities determined to be for the benefit of students (Education Code 39860)
- 4. District employees or parents/guardians traveling to and from educational activities authorized by the District (Education Code <u>39837.5</u>)
- 5. Preschool or nursery school students (Education Code 398000)
- 6. Students traveling to full-time occupational classes provided by a Regional Occupational Program or Center (Education Code <u>39807.5</u>, <u>41850</u>)
- 7. Students traveling to and from their places of employment during the summer in connection with a summer employment program for youth (Education Code 39837)
- 8. Matriculated or enrolled adults traveling to and from school, or adults pursuing other educational purposes (Education Code <u>39801.5</u>)
- 9. Private school students, in the same manner and on the same routes provided for District students (Education Code 39808)
- 10. Non-school purposes as allowed by law, such as:
 - a. Community recreation (Education Code 39835)
 - b. Public transportation (Education Code 39841)
 - c. Transportation of government employees to and from their places of employment (Education Code 39840)

The District shall provide home-to-school transportation and additional transportation services as needed for students with disabilities as specified in their individualized education programs. (Education Code <u>41850</u>; 20 USC <u>1400</u> - 1491; 34 CFR <u>104.4</u>)

The District shall provide homeless students with transportation services comparable to those offered to other students at the school of attendance. (42 USC <u>11432</u>)

The Superintendent or designee shall provide transportation to homeless children in accordance with law, Board policy and administrative regulation.
