Students Regulation # 5111

ADMISSION

Entrance to School

The middle and high schools will accept and place at the proper grade level those students who are promoted from feeder elementary schools of the District and those students transferring to this District from other school Districts. Grade level placement will be ascertained by means of official transcripts or records forwarded from the district of original attendance.

Admittance to Middle Schools

Students who reside in non-participating elementary school districts in the middle school programs will be admitted on inter-District attendance agreements on the same basis as the non-residents (cf. 5117 – Inter-District Attendance)

Admittance of Students to Mount Toro High School

Mount Toro High School is an alternative program for students. Students may elect to attend or be referred to Mount Toro t better met their unique educational needs.

Admittance to Schools of Students on Non-Immigrant Student Status

It is the policy of the District to accept non-immigrant students for enrollment in the schools of the District at the Board's discretion. American Field Service, Rotary Exchange, and other foreign exchange students as authorized by the Superintendent are approved. Non-immigrant students whose attendance in elementary schools has been authorized by component elementary districts will be accepted upon their promotion to the schools of the District.

Ages of Attendance

A student may be permitted to attend classes in the regular day schools of the District after reaching the age of 18. Such attendance is at the discretion of the Board of Trustees.

Students who have not met the requirements for promotion to the high schools may be promoted if it is deemed to be in the best interests of the student and the school. (cf. 5123 – Promotion/Acceleration/Retention)
