## STUDENT RESIDENCY WITH A CAREGIVER

When a Caregiver has lawfully executed a Caregiver Authorization Affidavit pursuant to sections 6550, et sea., of the California Family Code, and has otherwise met any and all other legal requirements, a properly identified student living in the Caregiver's home shall be deemed to have complied with the residency requirements for school attendance in Salinas Union High School District.

A student is considered to be "living in the Caregiver's home" if all of the following are true:

- 1. The student's personal property is kept at the Caregivers home.
- 2. The student spends the night at the Caregiver's home on all nights immediately preceding a school day, and on at least five out of seven days of each and every week during the year, (vacations out of the area excluded).
- 3. The Caregiver is legally eligible to and does in fact declare the student as a dependent on the Caregiver's federal and state tax returns. No other person may declare the student a dependent on any tax return.
- 4. The student does not receive any mail or maintain any telephone service at any address other than the Caregiver's address (or Post Office Box if applicable), or if mail is received at another address the student has informed the senders and the U.S. Post Office of his or her change of address.
- 5. Documentation regarding vehicle registration, voter registration, and any other interaction with the local, state or federal government identifies the student's address as being at the Caregiver's address.
- 6. The student has not entered into or continued a living arrangement with a Caregiver for the purpose of attending school in the Salinas Union High School District.
