CANDIDATE'S STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATION

Any person is eligible to be a Board Member if he/she is 18 years of age or older, a citizen of the State of California, a resident of the School District, a registered voter and not legally disqualified from holding office (Education Code 35107).

The Governing Board has made the following determinations with respect to the Candidate's Statement of qualifications submitted by candidates running for office within the District pursuant to Section 10012.5, Elections Code:

- 1. Candidates shall be allowed to submit a Candidate's Statement of Qualifications consisting of not more than 400 words
- 2. The District has determined that each candidate shall pay the cost of printing and handling the Candidate's Statement of Qualifications
- 3. The District has determined that no additional mailing of candidate's materials will be authorized by the Board pursuant to Section 10012.5, Elections Code. This determination should not be interpreted to discourage any candidate from making any political mailings on his own that the candidate sees fit to make.

(The County Clerk has been directed to accept the above policy as the official policy of this District in complying with the provisions of Section 10012.5, Elections code, for all future elections unless otherwise informed in writing at least 110 days prior to any election.)
