QUORUM/VOTING REQUIREMENTS/ABSTENTION VOTES

A majority of the members of the Governing Board shall constitute a quorum. Affirmative votes by a majority of the Board members are required to approve any action item under consideration regardless of the number of members present unless otherwise provided by law.

Four or more members shall constitute a quorum. Should there be less than four members of the Board present at a regular meeting, a time for the adjourned meeting shall be set by members present, and such adjourned meeting shall be deemed a regular meeting.

In determining the vote on any matter considered by the Governing Board, only actual votes for or against the matter shall be counted. Members of the Governing Board may abstain from voting on any matter before the Board, and such abstention vote shall not be counted for or against the matter. Nothing herein shall be construed to reduce the vote necessary for the Governing Board to take official action.
