Policy #1350

COMMUNITY RECREATION PROGRAMS

- 1. The Superintendent may establish programs of community recreation in the schools that will contribute to the physical, mental, or moral development of the individual or group participating therein. Such programs may include any activity in the fields of music, drama, art, handicraft, science, literature, nature study, aquatic sports, and athletics, or any informal play incorporating such activity.
- 2. The Superintendent shall supervise such recreation directors, supervisors, custodians, assistants, deputies, and other employees as appointed by the Board in connection with community recreation programs.

Purpose

The purpose of the community recreation program in the Salinas Union High School District shall be to promote and preserve the health and general welfare of the people of the district, and to cultivate the development of good citizenship by providing for adequate programs of community relation.
