HEALTH AND WELFARE BENEFITS

The District shall provide health and welfare benefits for certificated and classified employees in bargaining units in accordance with state and federal law and subject to negotiated employee agreements.

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Employees who are not in bargaining units shall receive similar benefits as those specified in the appropriate collective bargaining agreement.

Retired Employees

Retired employees and other qualified persons may continue to participate in the District's group health and welfare benefit plan and dental care benefit plan in accordance with state and federal law. The Superintendent or designee shall advise all employees of their rights and responsibilities related to continuing their health insurance benefits when their eligibility changes.
