GRANTING OF CREDIT

It shall be the policy of the District to allow each student to receive credit in specified subject areas, over a prescribed period of time, by demonstrating either by examination or other appropriate means that he has achieved or is in the process of achieving the highest level of competency of which he is capable during the period of time that the District has jurisdiction over his education.

A student may also receive credit by demonstrating, either by examination or other appropriate means, that he has achieved mastery or competence in a class or subject consistent with the goals and objectives of the District regardless of the time spent in class.

All subjects taught within the District for which credit is granted shall be consistent with the goals and objectives of the District and shall be reviewed as provided in the curriculum development policy and regulation.

The Superintendent shall develop regulations for the granting of credit in accordance with this policy insuring compliance with the Education Code and pertinent District regulations.
