

CURRICULUM COMPARABILITY

The District desires to provide an objective method of comparing courses which will provide an alternative means of graduation for students as directed in SB 813. The procedure would also be used in articulating with the Community College to compare their courses with the State's model curriculum standards for the granting of credit.

Through this process students would be permitted to receive credit toward graduation through alternative courses. Students may not receive more than ten units of credit per subject through an alternative means. It is designed to provide students who are non-college preparatory with alternatives to meeting graduation requirements. It will be incumbent on the student's counselor to evaluate individually the appropriateness of such alternative means.
