Instruction

MIDDLE SCHOOL PROMOTION

In order to recognize successful completion of middle school education, the Board of Trustees shall confer certificates of promotion from middle schools and from special day and evening classes of middle grades.

Certificates shall be awarded only to students who have completed the course of study prescribed by law and the District. (Education Code 51402)

Students shall have completed all required courses to participate in the middle school promotion ceremonies at the conclusion of the eighth grade.

In addition, students shall meet District requirements for promotion based on grades, assessments or other indicators as specified in Board policy and administrative regulation.
