TEXTBOOK ADOPTION

All basic and supplementary textbooks used in the Salinas Union High School District must be adopted formally by the Board of Trustees.

The Superintendent shall develop procedures for the study, recommendation and adoption of textbooks.

All textbook adoptions will be effective for a period of not less than five years unless it can be shown that the continued use of a given textbook is not educationally sound. In no case shall a textbook adopted by the Board be changed in less than three years.

Approval of a textbook by the Board does not constitute authority to purchase. Authority to purchase follows standard procedures.
