ADOPTION OF AGENGA

After the quorum was met the Agenda was adopted at 5:50 pm.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Sherrie Payne seconded the motion and the Minutes of March 17, 2004 were adopted with corrections.

Candy McCarthy, Principal at Alisal High School, spoke to the Committee regarding Alisal High's continuing needs with regards to the \$1.7 million to be moved to Everett Alvarez High School. She pointed out the stadium does not have restrooms as they were given up for the turf, but understands Alvarez will get restrooms and turf. Their bleachers do not match, and there is a need for a fence around the track.

Jesus Rogel Alisal ASB President, read a report he made to the students at the March 17, 2004 Bond Oversight Committee Meeting (see attached). Jesus also spoke of the need for bleachers that match

Pat Egan, President of School Site Council and teacher at Alisal High School, commented that the bond passed with a constant stream of projects for Alisal.

ALISAL HIGH SCHOOL \$1.7 MILLION

This item was moved up on the agenda for discussion with "Individuals Desiring to Address the Committee." After the committee was addressed, Karen Luna provided two handouts: (1) The First Issuance Project List and the reallocation of funds from Proposition 47 bond savings. Of that reallocation \$1.719 million was given to Alisal High before bidding to cover expected project costs. (2) The second handout reviewed funding sources, completed projects, summer maintenance projects and Measure F Second Issuance projects.

Gwen Miller made a motion for the committee to send a letter to the Board of Trustees and Dr. Elizondo, Superintendent, supporting projects on the first issuance project list. Discussion ensued regarding the restrooms at Alisal High stadium being a health issue and what the Committee's responsibility is. Mr. Earhart stated it is the intention of the Administration to get done as much as possible at all schools. The vote was called and the motion passed 7 ayes; 1 abstention (Brett Harrell); 0 against. The letter is to be developed and sent by Chairperson Bumba.

STATUS OF MEASURE F PROJECTS

Karen Luna reviewed the projects and expenditures with the Committee. Everett Alvarez High School was completed on April 2, 2004 and the contractor is working on punch list items.

LAND ACQUISITION UPDATE

Jim Earhart reported acquisition is still under discussion--no new changes.

REAPPOINTMENTS FOR MAY

May 14, 2004 is the end of term for some Committee members. Reappointment was accepted by Diane Ausonio, John Prader, Richard Diaz (e-mail request to be reappointed), Brett Harrell, and Abraham Magana.
