SPANISH-ENGLISH BILINGUAL AUTHORIZATION FOR IN-SERVICE TEACHERS

Santa Clara University is pleased to offer an innovative, online Bilingual Authorization program for in-service, K-12 teachers through the Center for Professional Learning in the School of Education and Counseling Psychology. Grounded in our Jesuit values for social justice, care for the whole person, and meeting the needs of our community, our Bilingual Authorization program prioritizes preparing teachers with a deep commitment to address equity and opportunity gaps for students, to understand the importance of maintaining home language while supporting English learning, and to bring a strengths- and asset-based framework to bilingual education.

Our Bilingual Authorization program is designed to prepare bilingual teachers that already hold a preliminary or clear teaching credential to earn a CA Bilingual Authorization. This Bilingual Authorization allows the holder to provide content instruction to English Learners in English and Spanish. The Bilingual Authorization allows teachers to work across a range of school settings including public, charter, private, and Catholic schools. The six month program allows in-service teachers to sharpen their Spanish language skills and cultural knowledge about Spanish-speakers through course assignments, readings, and discussions conducted in Spanish. The equity and social justice lens that guides the program provides a ripe context to discuss and challenge current models of bilingual education.

The Bilingual Authorization is an on-line program for elementary, middle and high school teachers that are bilingual in Spanish and English. Teachers complete the four course program through a combination of synchronous class sessions (via Zoom) and asynchronous readings, lessons, and classroom practice.

IN-SERVICE TEACHER BILINGUAL AUTHORIZATION

- Cohorts launch in June and January for this six-month program
- In-Service teachers enroll in 4 content-rich courses (Bilingual Foundations, Latinx Language & Culture, Bilingual Methods, Bilingual Seminar) taught in Spanish
- In-Service teachers apply what they are learning with students within their classroom and receive feedback from Bilingual program faculty
- After completing the program, In-Service teachers are recommended to the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing to receive the Bilingual Authorization add-on certification

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS FOR BILINGUAL AUTHORIZATION

- Online completed application
- Proof of applicant's valid California Preliminary or Clear Teaching Credential
- Statement of Purpose in Spanish (audio recorded)
- Passing score on CSET LOTE-Spanish III (not required for admission, but must be passed and submitted prior to completing the Bilingual Authorization)
- Current Resume or CV
- Employment verification
- One official copy of undergraduate transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended
- Two letters of recommendation
- \$50 application fee
- 2022-2023 Tuition: \$3,000
- Scholarships and federal grant support may be available
