Benefits of the Promise:

As a participant in the Salinas Valley Promise program, you receive:

- Full year of free college tuition, regardless of household income
- A free computer OR support for books or meals
- Participation in a summer leadership institute and quarterly workshops with fellow Promise students
- Mentoring by a local professional
- Preparation for an immediate career or transfer to CSU, UC and other universities

Accepting the Promise:

You are eligible for the Salinas Valley Promise if you are a graduate (diploma or GED) of a high school or adult school within the Hartnell Community College District, entering college for the first time.

To get started:

- Enroll as a full-time student (12 or more units per semester) at Hartnell for Fall 2019 and continue through Spring 2020. First-time students who enroll in Summer 2019 also qualify.
- Submit the **FAFSA (Free Application for Student Aid — <https://fafsa.ed.gov>)** OR the **California Dream Act Application (<https://dream.csac.ca.gov>)** and include Hartnell College on your application. To be considered for the Promise, the deadline is June 28, 2019.
- Select dates for a three-day leadership institute as part of the Promise program.
